The Summer Food Program provides **FREE** meals to children from the age of 1 to 18. Also, persons up to age 26 are eligible if they are enrolled in an educational program for the mentally or physically disabled that is recognized by a State or local public educational agency. The program is funded by the Michigan Dept of Education in cooperation with the US Dept of Agriculture.

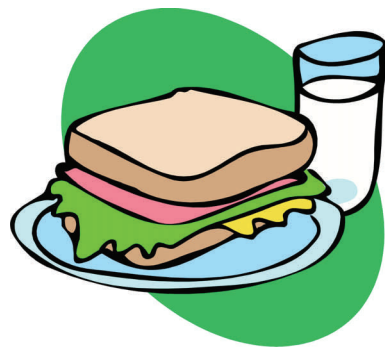
